

If you are a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, please follow these instructions to complete the endorsement requirement of the ELC application.

To start the endorsement process, you will need to go to the following website first to agree to the honor code: https://commtech.byu.edu/auth/honor/


1. Log in using your Net ID (username) and password. Click "NEXT" to proceed to the BYU Honor Code.




2. You will need to click on each Honor Code policy, Academic Honesty, Student Housing, Dress and Grooming Principles and Expectations, Same Sex Romantic Behavior and Student Standing and Ecclesiastical Endorsements. Once you have reviewed each policy, you will need to put a check mark on "I have reviewed the information contained in the links above and agree to follow these university policies." Click NEXT to proceed.






4. You will now be able to start the endorsement process. Click START ENDORSEMENT.




5. You will need to link your church account (The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints) with your BYU account. Click on the myaccount.byu.edu link.







## Start Endorsement

The Church Educational System (CES) is sponsored by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (Church) and directed by the Church Board of Education/Boards of Trustees, with the mission to develop disciples of Jesus Christ who are leaders in their homes, the Church, and their communities.

Applicants who are members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints must receive an endorsement from the priesthood leaders of their unit of record. In most cases, this means you need to visit with your bishop or branch president and with a member of your stake or mission president.

You should engage with your priesthood leaders to ensure your endorsement is complete by the deadline.



- 12. As a Latter-Day Saint student, you can only be endorsed by the bishop of the ward you belong to or the ward that holds your membership record.
- 13. Once you have completed the endorsement request, you will have access to print pages with endorsement instructions. The bishop will receive your endorsement request via email, but you should contact them to set up the first interview.
- 14. Once you have completed the interview with your bishop and your bishop has reported the interview in the system, you will be able to schedule an interview with the Stake President.
